



## Rev. George Pierson Dominick

September 10, 1918 - January 1, 2016

Reverend George Pierson Dominick, a native of Pittsfield, Mass., died peacefully at his home on January 1, 2016. He was 97 yrs old. He is predeceased by his parents, W.G. (electrical engineer) and Mary Elliott (RN), and older brother, William (patent attorney). As a child, George did cross country skiing in the beautiful Berkshire Mtns and pole vaulted while studying philosophy at Oberlin College. He received his masters in theology from Hartford Seminary. He was baptized, confirmed, and then ordained (1945) in the Congregational Church. He loved the UCC church and initiated an adult class that is over 15 years old. He rarely missed church. He pastored a church in Concord, NH, but felt his true calling as clinical chaplain in the service of others. He was the first Protestant chaplain at St Louis Hospital. He also worked in federal corrections, mental hospitals, and alcohol/drug addiction. George had a way of helping others grow and learn as he supervised a training program for chaplains at the Georgian Clinic (now DeKalb Addiction). His last job was Director of A & D programs for DeKalb County. He also served as a Supervisor in ACPE and was head of chaplaincy certification for the US. George had many interests and hobbies. He was a wonderful cook and enjoyed sharing food and talk with family and friends around his table. Chicken potpie, from a Gourmet Mag recipe, was a favorite. He made his own sauerkraut, and vinegar, cured hams, kept bees, carved wood. He tended gardens, koi ponds, and bonsai trees (some over 50 years old). He was a kind and gentle soul, who believed in the worth of all people. He was rarely angry

and always full of grace. He is survived by his loving wife Jackie Graves, daughter Robyn Smith (Brad), Jackie's son, Lee Graves (Brooke), four step grandchildren, and grandchildren (Kyle and Kade), and niece, Kim Fair (Reuben) and many other nieces and nephews. Memorial service at Central Congregational UCC, Jan 9 at 4 pm. In lieu of flowers, George requested donations to Central Church UCC.
