MORRIS- George Nathan "Nat" Morris entered into eternal peace on September 16, 2014. A brilliant light that was vanquished long before his time, Nathan was a vibrant, deeply loving and inspiring soul to many throughout his remarkable life, which began on December 31, 1959 in Atlanta, Ga. The youngest son of eight children to James Edward and Dorothy Mae Morris. He graduated from Dacula High School in 1978, and began working for Ted Turner at CNN in 1980. In 1986, he became a Minister at the High Church of Man and went on to gain certification as in Drug and Alcohol Abuse Counseling. He also studied psychology in 1988 at Mercer University, earning an Associates Degree with Deans List honors. Nathan was well traveled and visited all 52 states of our country, including living and working at Ross University of Veterinary Medicine, on St. Kitts Island in the Caribbean, as a counselor and a bookstore Manager. He was also the Proprietor of Garden Basket Florist in Lawrenceville, Georgia. 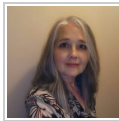
