Glenda Dawn Kinney Kelley died suddenly from cardiac arrest on September 1, 2016 in Snellville, GA. She was preceded in death by her father, Harold W. Kinney in 2000, and her mother, Mildred McNinch on August 20, 2016. She is survived by her husband, Charles, son John Kemmer, daughter, Dawn (Aaron) Hubler, all of Snellville; three grandchildren; siblings, H. Lee Kinney, of Wintersville, OH; James C. (Cheryl) Kinney and Carole Kinney, of Richmond, OH; Sharon K. Reynolds and Janeen G. Kinney of Snellville, GA. There are many nephews, nieces, and cousins. Glenda and family moved to Gwinnett County in 1982. After early retirement she assisted her husband Charles in his fight against the Government Abuse of this Nation's Veterans'/Widows' going to Congress numerous times. She was never too tired to try and help a Veteran or Widow in their fight for "government earned benefits". At her husband's military reunions she became the calming effect for many of the men traumatized by the effects of war; as well their spouses. She will be horribly missed by her family and by what she called "HER Veterans".
