“ Gordon was my big brother. We shared a room in our house on North 29th in Lincoln, and also on South 60th in Lincoln. It couldn't have been a great time for him being ten years older, but he took it all in stride and helped me grow up. We shared a radio and I remember going to sleep and waking up with the raucous sounds of KLMS AM Rock and Roll Lincoln. I can remember the lyrics of tunes I heard over and over. Gordon was a member of the Southeast High School swim team. did he ever share that with anyone? I remember him being very athletic and he could accomplish any athletic challenge he came up against. He loved cars and was a Member of the Rebels Car Club in Lincoln, He was awful, though, as a mechanic and was NOT someone you wanted to work on your car. He moved out when I was about 9 or ten and I missed him terribly and probably acted out because of it. Eventually he moved to North Carolina and left me with a bunch of his clothes. My favorite was a Green Shark Skin suit that shimmered green, gold, and black depending on which direction you turned. He had really big feet so the shoes he left for me were too big but I still wore them. I thought I was his buddy and he always treated me like it. Eventually I moved out of home and moved to North Carolina with him and Pat. 943 Archdale Drive to be specific. I got busy right away looking for a job and landed one at R. H. Boulighny Manufacturing Company in Charlotte. He helped me buy a car and a set of tools I needed for work ( I still have them). He was not only a great role model, but an entertainer as well. Right before I went into the Air Force, he made sure to take me on a Golf outing which Pat and I remember very well! After my tour over seas, I spent some time with Gordon and he was nice enough to take me to the Airport in Atlanta for my flight home to Nebraska. He told me he was proud of my service and always remember I had a home wherever he was. I miss him terrible and our good times.
