I just laughed and said "I guess so!" and from then on she was "Honey" to me and my little family. What a fitting name for someone so sweet.

Grace was a tremendously strong woman who dealt with so much hurt and loss over her lifetime, and yet she always kept her eyes on God and her faith in Him never wavered. Her love for others was palpable, and her faith was powerful. She dealt with tragic loss, and ailment after ailment and still made time to serve others. She made countless bears from the clothing of people's loved ones, she charged WAY too little for her AMAZING creations, and she was endlessly humble. She told me once that she couldn't get her lawn mower to start and so she prayed over it and it started right up! And of course, there were the many sleepovers I would have at her little basement apartment, and she would put her cold feet on me in the bed. She had such a surprising and fun sense of humor! As I child I learned that you don't dare walk away and leave what you were playing with laying out because in a flash you'd come back to play with it and she would have cleaned away any trace of it, haha! She was kind, and loving, and steadfast. I remember our weekly Bible Studies when we were kids and how she would create such a feast for us! I remember cramming so many people into her little apartment for Thanksgiving that it was basically standing room only. I have had so many people that have known her tell me that they had "adopted" her as their honorary mother or grandmother, and I always remember being so flattered by that, but at the same time, so honored that she was my REAL grandmother. She loved my husband for being a handsome Navy man like her Frank and it made me so proud, although we never did get around to getting him

*dressed up in uniform to show off to her! I have so many things to remind me of her and for that, I am so thankful. I am so glad that we named our daughter after her and that I have so many reminders of her love all around my home.*
