Grannis Fowler, known by friends and family as "G.W.", was born December 2, 1945, in Lawrenceville, GA, passed away on Wednesday, August 1, 2012. A Graveside Service will be held at 3:00 PM., August 6, 2012, at Gwinnett Memorial Park, Lawrenceville. All friends welcomed to attend. G.W. lived most of his life in Lawrenceville, except for the years he served in the U.S. Army, as a military policeman with the Army CID, during the Vietnam War, from 1966-1970. One memorable detail was honor guard duty at General Eisenhower's state funeral in Kansas. G.W. continued a career in law enforcement by proudly serving as a Detective/Patrolman with the City of Atlanta Police Department for 25 years. Besides his devotion to public safety and law enforcement, G.W. had a talent for drawing and story telling. He told the story, but added a personal flavor that could make the most common events entertaining and comical.

G.W. enjoyed riding motorcycles, loved his old dog Redbone, and seemed to be able to have a conversation with anyone.

G.W. was preceded in death by his father and mother, Gordon L. and Mae H. Fowler; sister, Mary Alice Green, and brother, Glendon L. Fowler.
