Tucker - Harriet Virginia Hanner Tucker of Loganville died Friday, November 4, 2011. A native of Decatur, Georgia, she was born December 4, 1924, the daughter of Alfred W. Her first job was on the staff of Emory Hospital, and she worked for many years in Pediatrics at Grady.
