He was a member and Deacon of North Metro Baptist Church, for 31 years. After moving to Madison he joined Sandy Creek Baptist Church, and was a member for 24 years. Henry was preceded in death by his son, David, and brother, Preston. He enjoyed being outdoors on his farm, running his tractor, and hunting & fishing. He enjoyed traveling, and especially to Alaska, where

he and his wife, Ann, went for over 25 years. He loved God, his family, & his country. And he will be dearly missed.
