WILLIAMS – Howard Williams, age 77 of Snellville, GA, passed away on Tuesday, April 22, 2025 at his home. A Memorial Service will be held at 3:00 PM on Sunday, May 4, 2025 in the Loganville Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home with Robert Williams officiating.
