



Hoyt Glenn Frisbee

June 24, 1936 - December 15, 2024

FRISBEE – Hoyt Glenn Frisbee, age 88 of Lawrenceville, Georgia, passed away on Sunday, December 15, 2024. A Funeral Service will be held at 1:00 PM on Thursday, December 19, 2024, in the Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home in Lawrenceville with Pastor Jody Everett and Rev. Rex Richards officiating. Entombment will follow at East Shadowlawn Memorial Gardens, 87 Scenic Highway, Lawrenceville. Hoyt served honorably as a Sergeant in the United States Army. He retired from the State of Georgia after 30 years of service and was an educator at the Gwinnett Hall Bible College and had a doctorate in Theology. Hoyt was a dedicated member of the Gwinnett Hall Baptist Church. He loved to travel, not only with his family, but also on mission trips for the church. Hoyt was preceded in death by his first wife of 54 years, Linda (Morris) Frisbee, second wife, Lola (Rushing) Frisbee, and parents, Woodrow and Jewel (Whitworth) Frisbee. He is survived by his son and daughter-in-law, Kenn & Cyndi Frisbee; grandchildren, Kyle Frisbee, Tyler & Jenn Frisbee; and great grandson, Elijah Frisbee.
