Interment will be in Hillcrest Cemetery, Loganville, GA. Mrs. Wheeler, a native of Loganville, GA, and long-time Gainesville, GA resident, died March 7, 2007, after an extended illness. Mrs. Wheeler was valedictorian of the class of 1964 at Loganville High School. She came from a long line of educators, and she, too, was an educator. She earned a Bachelor in Arts degree in English and Master of Education degree in English from the University of Georgia. As an honors student she graduated cum laude and ranked in the top five percent of her class. Throughout her education, she was an honors scholar. In her freshman year at UGA, she was chosen Freshman Camper and elected to Alpha Lambda Delta and the Z Club. In her senior year, she was elected to Kappa Delta Pi, Phi Kappa Phi, and Phi Beta Kappa. Mrs. Wheeler's teaching career began in 1968 teaching in the Gainesville City School System. She recently taught English at Lanier Technical College. Mrs. Wheeler was a dog lover, especially of English

Springer Spaniels. She has owned this breed for 34 years, and has been a breeder and exhibitor of springers since 1985. She was a charter member of the Chattahoochee English Springer Spaniel Club of Greater Atlanta. She served the club by holding many positions throughout the years. Mrs. Wheeler was a lifelong member of Loganville Christian Church. Over the years, she had served the church in many capacities such as president of Christian Youth Fellowship, choir member, and recently was the church historian. 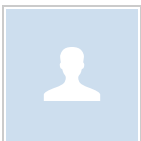
