Jan Roe, age 84 of Loganville, passed away Wednesday evening, June 9, 2021, with loved ones at her side. If you knew Jan Roe, you loved her. Owner of Candy Castle Day Care with her late husband, Billy Roe, Mrs. Jan was a mother to anyone who walked through her doors.

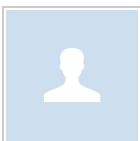
