“ I met Jason our Freshman year of high school together at St Pete High and we instantly became close friends. He was always up to mischief of some sort but at the same time had a strong moral compass. He was a deep thinker. He was serious about life and what our places were in the universe. He had a deep respect for our country and the military that protect her. He was always much much older than his years (like George Bailey from a Wonderful Life).

There are too many stories to tell about all of our adventures but one that stands out was when we both got fed up of not having access to a boat where we lived on Florida's gulf cost. So Jason decided to built one....

We rode our bikes to Bobby Lee Tires on 4 th street and bought two truck inner tubes. We lashed a ply wood top to them and then screwed on stadium seats. We then had a friend strap this contraption to his car roof and we got dropped off at the Shore Acres bridge. We brought 2 paddles.

Somewhere along the line Jay got committed to only eating fish we caught. I hedged my bet and brought some dry food but not Jay. We paddled to a tiny island in the bayou and there we sat for 8 hours in the Florida sun and true to his word, Jason ate one Pin fish and some awful crustacean we pulled out of the pollution.

Friends of ours (who owned a boat) had heard of our antics and came out to see us and offered to tow us and our boat back to the bridge. I took them up on the offer to ride in their boat but Jay would only accept the ride under one condition: that he remain on his hand crafted boat. Half way back to the bridge while under tow, they gunned the engine and we started hydro planning and our boat began coming apart all around Jay Burg while he held on. .. I can still see him to this day, 26 years later, his determined face stern and holding on for the principle of not releasing from his boat while the whole damn thing ripped apart beneath him! Nothing was left save for the ply wood and some rope. It was funny for a brief moment but that didn't last. What I was left with, to this day, was that JBurg represented something about the way a man should live a life. He had a certain defiance against anything that was not

genuine. Jay Burg, even at the young age of 13, taught me to hold on to the things I've built (like that ramshackle boat) even when they are under assault and to never abandon that which I love.

Rest in peace Jason, you filled your life with so many adventures that you packed 200 years into 40.

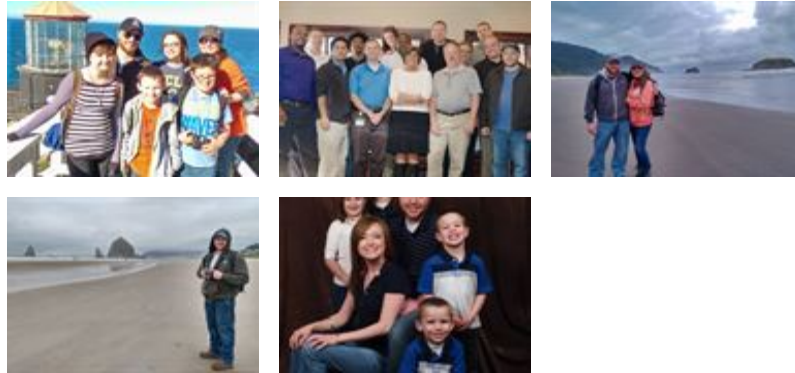
