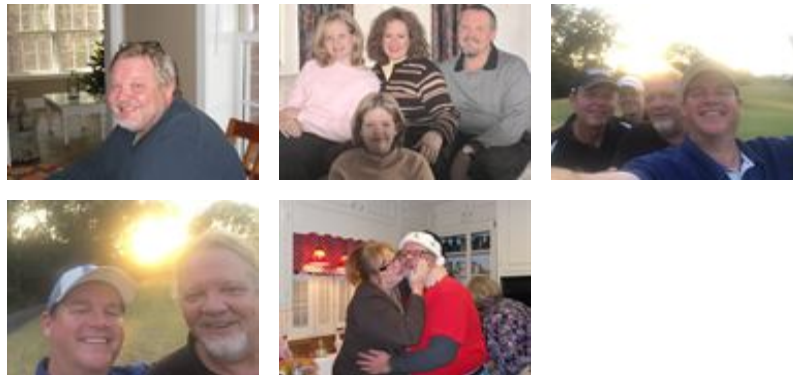

After it threw me off a bit, I recalled our days back in the late 70's and very early 80s where Jay was our drummer for our teenage rock band, Storm. I smiled as I remember my first days being on stage and in front of audiences and how it brought me to this point - all these years later - as a stage actor. Jay and his family had much to do with this. They were immensely talented musicians and all-round great people. His father, pastor of The Tabernacle Church in downtown Lawrenceville (North Metro Atlanta), allowed us to use the sanctuary for practices and rehearsals. We played Elvis songs, The Eagles, and lots of other awesome covers from the 70s, primarily. Some great times indeed.
