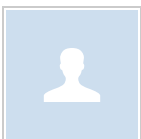

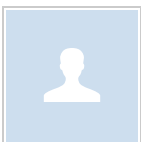

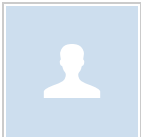


“ We are honored and blessed to have known Jeff.
