



Jerome Lebowski

March 10, 1917 - May 30, 2009

LEBOWSKI - Jerome Lebowski was born March 10, 1917 in Detroit, Michigan. He was a graduate of Owosso High School and attended the Berlitz School of Languages in Detroit. Jerome worked for the Detroit Ordinance District in the early 1940s. Because of his war work and support of his mother and brother, he received a high draft number under selective service, which meant he would be among the last to be called up. Instead, he volunteered and was inducted into the Army on April 10, 1943. Because of his ordinance experience, Pvt. Lebowski was recommended for the Aberdeen Proving Ground in Maryland, but instead was sent to Ft. McClellan in Alabama for infantry training. He was sent to Europe as a member of the Medical Detachment of the 346th Infantry. His unit participated in the Battle of the Bulge in the Ardennes Forest, in Belgium as a Medic. Sgt. Lebowski was discharged from the Army on February 11, 1946 at Ft. Dix New Jersey. After the war, he worked for the Veterans Administration, the Air Force and finally for the Army Missile Command at Redstone Arsenal located in Huntsville Alabama as the Chief of Program Management for the Chaparral Missile Program. He retired from Redstone in 1975 after 30 years. He had four sons: Robert Lebowski, deceased; Dow Lebowski of Los Angeles, CA, who is a distribution sales manager for Harper Corporation; Dwight Lebowski, also of Los Angeles, CA, who works for Fox Network as a broadcast engineer; and David Lebowski, an attorney in Monroe, GA; brother, Eugene Lebowski; sister, Irene Lebowski, both of Southfield, MI.
