November 19, 1939 - October 10, 2017

Jerry Nelson Butcher, 77, of Snellville, GA died suddenly on October 10, 2017. Also known as Dad, Papaw, JerBear, Old Man, Mr. Jerry and Uncle Homer, Jerry never met a person he couldn't or wouldn't talk to. Born in Weston, West Virginia in 1939, he remained a proud West Virginian even as he moved with his family to other states. Before retiring to be a stay at home Dad, he was the ultimate salesman, selling commercial doors and hardware for more than 35 years. He leaves behind his best friend, love of his life and wife of 28 years, Jennifer Appel Butcher, five wonderful children; his daughters, Dr. Pamela Butcher Redman, aka Smurf, (partner Frank Waugh) and Kristina Butcher Gold (Danny), and his sons David Robert Butcher, Daniel Nelson Butcher (Kailey Thompson) and Isaac Joseph Butcher, and four granddaughters he loved beyond belief; Polly, Piper, Gwen and Jocelyn. He will be also be missed by his two brothers, a host of in-laws, nieces, nephews and friends who always laughed at his "bad jokes" and his many rescued pets, especially his obsessively devoted dog, Beans. Jerry made the decision long ago to be an organ donor and his family feels blessed that his liver is going to someone who needs it now. Jerry and his family took many long and memorable camping vacations to see this country and he liked to brag that the only state he never got to was Hawaii. He once described his perfect day as one that included "family, a good nap, a good drink and good food". Funeral mass will be held Saturday, October 14, 2017 at 11 am at St. Oliver Plunkett Catholic Church in Snellville. A brief visitation will be held prior to the mass in

the narthex of the Church.
