Jerome (Jerry) Philip Henning of Loganville, GA passed away peacefully with his family by his side on January 24, 2025.

Jerry was born in 1937 to the late Adam and Helen Henning in Cloverport, KY. One of six siblings who all grew up in nearby Irvington, KY, Jerry graduated from Irvington High School in the class of 1957. Following graduation, he served in the United States Army at Fort Benning, GA where he became an expert rifleman in the 9th Infantry. Upon leaving the US Army, Jerry was hired by L & N Railroad, later known as CSX, and worked as a member of a railroad “gang” maintaining tracks and equipment from Evansville, IN to Mobile, AL. Jerry retired from the railroad as a signalman in the signal repair shop after working for the company for 42 years.

Jerry loved dancing, music, and art. At a young age, his brother-in-law, Clement Raffauf, taught him how to dance, especially jitterbug, which was really popular at the time.

Jerry was often the first one on the dance floor no matter his age. He and his wife, Bernadette, enjoyed square and round dancing for many years and maintain friends from that community to this day. Jerry played a multi-register organ, as well as piano, both for church services and personal enjoyment. You could often find him playing and singing on a Sunday afternoon or for family and friends. In addition to dancing and music, Jerry is considered an artist by his family. He was talented in woodworking and many textile crafts. A man who was very hard working and could fix almost anything, Jerry knew how to enjoy life and have a good time.

Jerry is predeceased by his siblings Jacquelyn Raffauf (Clement), Elizabeth Gordon (Homer), Louis Henning (Joyce), and John Henning.

Jerry is survived by his wife, Marie Bernadette (Huffine); his daughter, Celest Tobler (Troy); grandchildren, Adam and Johnathan; his sister, Lois Henning; sister-in-law, Joyce Henning; as well as many beloved nieces and nephews.

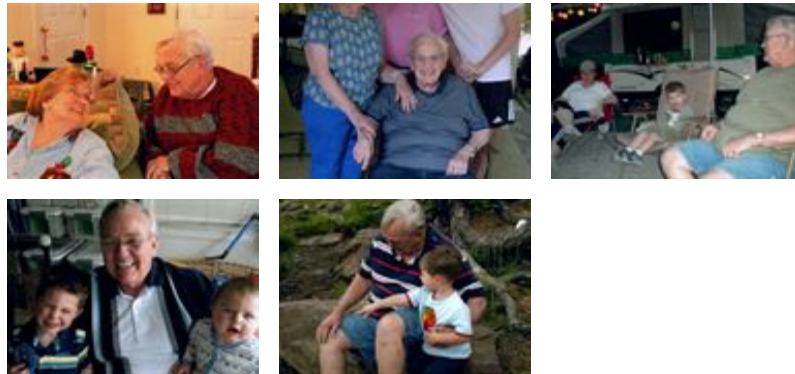
