



## Jerry Wayne Waldrip

July 8, 1944 - March 17, 2025

WALDRIP - Jerry Wayne Waldrip, age 80 of Lawrenceville, Georgia passed away on Monday, March 17, 2025. 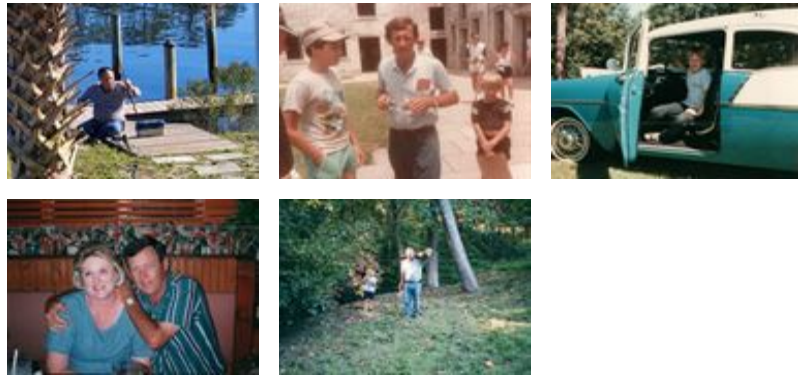
