She was instrumental in having several Georgia state laws passed to promote inclusion for children like her daughter. Former Georgia Governor Zell Miller invited Jill, her family, and other special needs families involved with legislative change through The Arc of GA to the State Capitol to

personally thank them for their dedication to upholding the rights of disabled children. Over the years, Jill and her husband opened their home, taking in and helping several family members. Jill was always willing to help out family and friends when they were in need and for many years volunteered in coordinating the annual Christmas luncheon for the elderly at the American Legion Post 264, where she and her husband were members. Jill was an honest woman who always spoke the truth and fought for those who did not have a voice. Jill will be greatly missed by those who love her. After years of health struggles, Jill is now at peace, surrounded once again by her loving family.
