COKER – Jim Coker, age 85 of Grayson, passed away on Thursday, January 22, 2026. A Funeral Service will be held at 1:00 PM on Friday, January 30, 2026 in the Lawrenceville Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home. Interment will follow at Haynes Creek Cemetery, 3995 Rosebud Road, Loganville. Jimmy was a proud 1958 graduate of Loganville High School, where he was captain of the basketball team. After graduation, he attended the University of Georgia, graduating in 1964 with a BA in Political Science. He also attended Woodrow Wilson College of Law, achieving his Juris Doctorate in 1973. Jimmy was an Eagle Scout and a veteran of the United States Army. He was the owner of State Farm Insurance Agency in Snellville for 37 years, insuring generations of families in the Gwinnett and Walton County area. He was a member of the American Legion in Loganville, the cemetery committee at Haynes Creek Baptist Church, and the Historical Society of Loganville, where he contributed to the Loganville Heritage Journal. Jimmy was known for his generosity, sense of humor, and valued service to others and community. He also enjoyed researching local history and genealogy and was an avid Dawg fan. Jimmy was preceded in death by his parents, Calvin and Pearl (Brooks) Coker; brother, Sammy Coker; and sister, Martha Jane Baker. He is survived by his loving wife of 55 years, Kaye Coker of Grayson; daughters, Jennifer Lee Coker of Grayson; Jessica Ann Coker of Jefferson; grandsons, Jaxon C. Bagwell and James W. 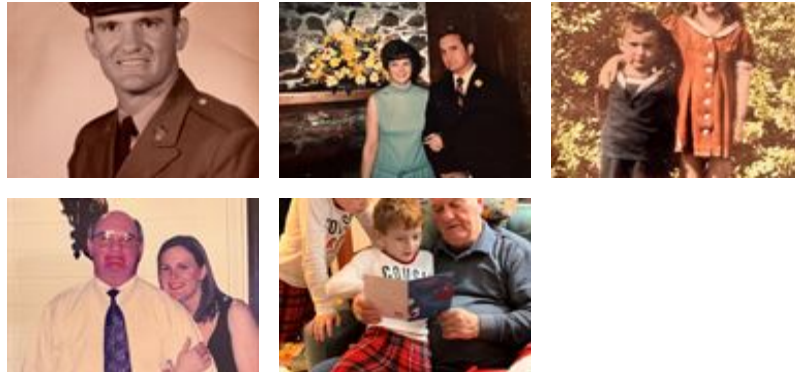
