Jim's love for life was matched by his deep bond with his beloved dog, Sol, who brought him countless moments of happiness and comfort. Sol was more than a pet to Jim; he was a true companion and source of joy. His girlfriend Keila and him shared many happy and peaceful moments, creating memories

that would last a lifetime. Their relationship was built on mutual love, respect, and understanding.

A proud and honorable Marine, Jim served with distinction in the United States Marine Corps. 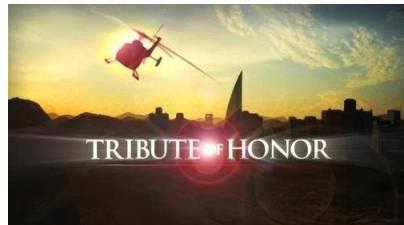

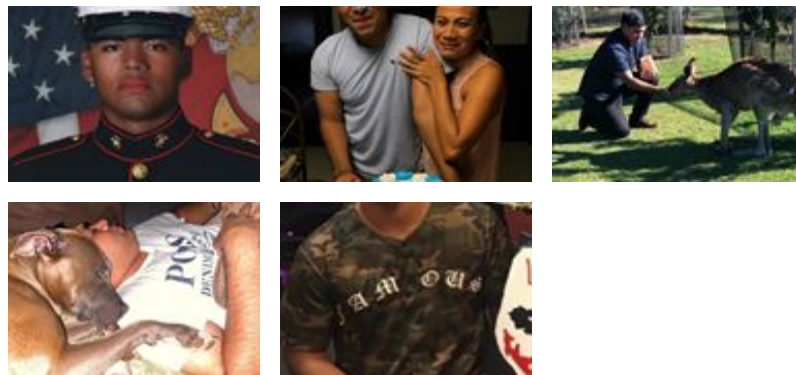
