Harris – Joe Norman Harris age 87 of Cape Coral, FL, passed away on Thursday, November 5, 2020. 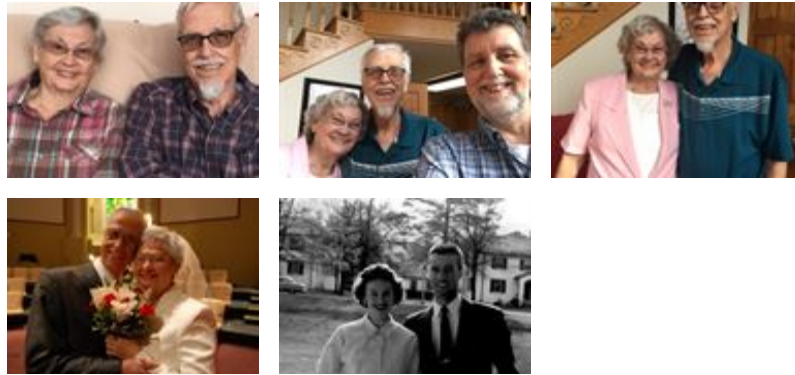
