He would say “mama what do you need?” what do you want”? “Do you want me to get your med from the house?” “Do you want some water?” He felt so helpless, knowing that she was on her death bed and there was nothing he could do for her. Joel did have a good and gentle soul just like the rest of the Lacy brothers Another thing I remember about Joel, is that when he didn't have to be at work, he loved to come to family reunions or family gatherings, even though you could count on

him being one to two hours late, but at least he was there if he could. He loved the food too and also liked to talk. And if you disagreed with him, he would say "Well that's my opinion and I'm entitled to it". Or "well I'm just saying, you know what I mean, I'm just saying". So yes, he has left a hole in our hearts, and he will be missed, specially at family gatherings and holidays. So you asked Who was Joel?
