Mr. John Hugh Arrendale, formerly of Tate, GA passed away peacefully on Wednesday Dec 6, 2023 at his assisted living home in Loganville, GA. He was 98 years old.

Mr. Arrendale was predeceased by his wife Ruth Cox Arrendale of Tate, GA. He is survived by two daughters Lynne & (Wallace) Harper of Loganville, GA and Marsha & (Phil) Craig of Nokomis, FL; one grandson Benjamin & (Megan) Craig of Peachtree City, GA, and two great grandchildren John (Jack) and Addison Craig.

Mr. Arrendale proudly served as a Sargent in the Army Air Corps during World War II. In his early career, he worked with the REA in building some of the earliest power lines in the North Georgia mountains, and then he had a long career with The Georgia Marble Company serving as their electrical foreman.

Mr. Arrendale will be interred beside his wife at Cool Springs Baptist Church Cemetery in Tate, GA with the Reverend Jimmy Orr officiating. The graveside service will be held on Wednesday, December 13, 2023 at 11:00am.
