Throughout their sports careers, he coached everything from basketball to baseball to softball- even soccer. He always did this with patience, encouragement, and a genuine love for each of his players, especially his son and daughter.

His shaved ice business became a true passion project, one that allowed him to build community and give back through frequent fundraisers supporting local causes.
