“ John was responsible for getting me hooked on turkey hunting with a passion that has grown immensely.. We hunted religiously that first year after he finally twisted my arm enough to get me to go with him, but did not harvest a bird. The second year I reluctantly agreed to give it one more try. Plans were made to meet at camp the evening before opening day on Saturday. John called me that week to inform me that his mother passed away in Colorado, and he needed to be there instead, but insisted that I go hunting to honor her as her funeral was also on Saturday. I reluctantly agreed. I sat in the woods Saturday morning for several hours thinking more about his mom when a turkey gobble rattled me from about 40 yards away. The bird played with my head for more than 40 minutes until a turkey hen passed behind me and drew him out of the trees. I made the shot and ran to my first ever turkey, thanking God and Bubba along the way. I gathered my turkey over my shoulder and began the trek out of the woods. After about 15 minutes, my phone rang - it was John calling from Colorado. I asked him how the funeral went and he told me it was a beautiful service with doves being released about 15 minutes earlier - the exact same moment that I made the shot! My emotions went wild. He asked me if I killed a bird, and fighting back tears, I told him the story. I will forever remember and cherish that day. Thank you Bubba - I love you and will forever keep you in my heart.
