



John Wendell Patton

November 27, 1943 - November 6, 2022

On November 6, 2022, John Wendell Patton passed away at home in Bethlehem, Georgia at the age of 78. Wendell was preceded in death by his parents John Harrison and Ruby Lee Nora Patton, sister and brother-in-law Carolyn and Jimmy Alford, and nephew Art Alford. He was a member at Ebenezer Baptist Church in Dacula for many years, serving as greeter and attending men's Bible study. Additionally, he volunteered every week making deliveries for StreetWise Georgia Food Bank. Wendell was known for being a wonderful and loving father/grandfather, a talented piano player, his sense of humor and charismatic personality. He was often telling hilarious stories or playing practical jokes on his friends/family. He was a life-long member of Sexton Farm in Mitchell where he

enjoyed hunting, and he loved to cook, faithfully guarding his secret recipe for barbecue sauce. 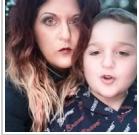

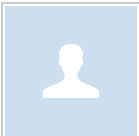

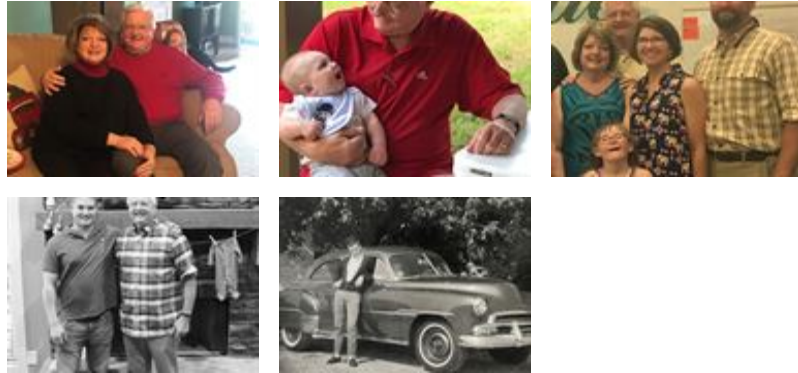
