BAILEY- John J. Bailey, age 75 of Loganville, GA passed away quietly on October 21, 2009 at 3:10 AM. Funeral Services will be Monday, October 26, 2009 at 10:00 AM in the Loganville Chapel of Tim Stewart Funeral Home, followed by a graveside military service at 1:00 PM at the Georgia Veterans Memorial Cemetery in Milledgeville, with Pastor Derek Lawrence and Rev. Wayne Sosebee officiating. Mr. Bailey was the son of John L. Bailey and Ada Lou McKinney Bailey of Sneads, FL. He served in the Korean Conflict (1950-1953), with the United States Air Force, then married Emily Culver in 1957. During their 52 years of marriage, they had 4 children and 5 grandchildren. He graduated from Chipola College and Technical School, Marianna, Florida then moved to Georgia to work as a civil engineer on the Lake Lanier Buford Dam Project in the early 1960's. Subsequent, Mr. Bailey owned and operated his own construction businesses for nearly 30 years once the family moved to metro Atlanta. He collaborated on important Atlanta area projects such as the initial development and several construction projects at the planned community of Peachtree City, south of Atlanta, as well as certain aspects of the Peachtree Plaza complex. Mr. Bailey was a Freemason and many years an active member of the Atlanta Chapter of the Scottish Rite. Mr. Bailey particularly enjoyed participating in fund-raising events in support of the Scottish Rite Children's Hospital. He enjoyed his work and those who worked with him. He enjoyed frequent visits to the Florida coast and Seminole lakes with family members. For many years, he most enjoyed spending his spare

time fishing, boating and camping at Lake Lanier. He also visited his sisters and brother in Florida quite often. His greatest joy was his family, grandsons and his friends. Those who knew Mr. Bailey will miss his love for cooking, family gatherings and his jovial personality. Mr. Bailey will long be remembered by staff and patients for his kindness and contributions to the VA Hospital speech therapy rehabilitation and support group programs. He is survived by his Wife: Emily Culver Bailey; a Son, Daughters and Sons-in-Law: John Joseph Bailey, Stephanie Bailey and Garry McCarty, Melanie Bailey and Alexander G.
