Mr. Wallis served in the US Army during WWII, 100th Infantry Division, 325th Engineer Battalion. After his tour of duty in the military he returned to the farm in

Grayson that he and his wife purchased prior to his military departure and remained on that farm until his death. For many years he farmed, grew chickens for commercial use and raised registered cattle. In addition he worked in residential home construction and in 1991 retired from Gwinnett County as a residential building inspector. After his retirement he enjoyed the fellowship of his breakfast friends in Lawrenceville, his Friday night dinner friends, working around the farm raising cows and gardening.
