Joyce Maddox Thompson of Bold Springs entered eternal life Wednesday, March 10, 2016. She was seventy years old.

She was a caretaker and a friend to all who knew her, and a shining example of a fair and

kind woman.

Joyce fell ill about a year ago, and was cared for at home by Steve and her children for much of that time. She was especially well taken care of by the light of her life, her daughter Vicki. She spent her very last days surrounded by family and friends at Athens Regional Medical Center. She was able to see and visit with most of her family before passing away very peacefully early Thursday morning. She died with family at her side, holding her hands.

Her family and friends will remember her walking Sarah's Creek with a pole in her hand, catching her limit of trout, and sending a few of them back to camp with the grandkids so she could keep going. She'll be remembered as the doting mother and grandmother observing her loud, loving family from her corner chair in the living room.
