Judith (Judy) Albert Thompson, age 85, of Grayson, Georgia passed away peacefully on Saturday April 2nd after a long battle with Lewy body dementia. Judy was born September 20, 1936, in Athens, Georgia to parents, Charles R. Albert and Margaret Sorrells Albert. She graduated from Athens High School in 1954 and attended Georgia College for Women in Milledgeville as well as Emory University in Atlanta where she earned a degree in Medical Records. After college, Judy worked in the Medical Records Department at Athens General Hospital.

Judy met her future husband, Grannon Isaiah Thompson, on a blind date in Athens, Georgia in 1960 and was married 6 months later. They enjoyed 61 years of marriage.

Judy's top priorities were supporting her husband, a pharmacist, and raising her family in Claxton, Georgia where she was active in community events. She always longed for the red clay of the North Georgia Mountains and she and Grannon moved to the Skylake community in Sautee, Georgia after retirement. Judy was an active bridge player and a social butterfly in this new environment, culminating in being named Skylake Woman of the Year by her peers. Judy was also very involved with the Nacoochee Presbyterian Church as a deacon as she welcomed visitors and many new members. She and Grannon enjoyed 17 wonderful years in the Skylake Community.

Judy enjoyed arts and craft projects through the years. She sewed, stenciled, decorated, and sold gourds, collected, and pressed flowers for frames, and

spent countless hours in the garden. One of her favorite joys was a houseful of family.

Judy is survived by her husband, Grannon Thompson, of Grayson, Georgia; children Gregory Albert Thompson (Maria) of Santa Rosa Beach, FL, Alan Daniel Thompson (Kathy) of Dallas, Texas, Jill Thompson Wright (Patrick) of Durham, North Carolina, and Lynn Thompson Bradley (Wally) of Lawrenceville, Georgia; sisters Diane Adams and Jeannie Hartis of Athens, Georgia. She was most proud of her many grandchildren: Michelle Jeffcoat (Rob), Andrew Thompson (Taylor), Eric Thompson, Grady Thompson, Phillip Thompson, Sarah Wright, Claire Wright, Walker Bradley (Jordan), and Benjamin Bradley (Colleen); and great grandson Wyatt Jeffcoat.
