“ June Hankins

This morning on the eve of June’s homegoing celebration, as I awoke at 4:45 AM, my first thought was, “God, you must be so pleased to have June Hankins at home with you.” For me, “an at-home person” well describes who June was in my life. Although I never had the joy of stepping into her personal home, for many years I did have the pleasure of stepping into her emotional and spiritual home as we worshipped together at the Assembly of God Tabernacle in Decatur, GA.

June was a woman who was stable and steady. She always presented herself well. She was not pretentious. She was a lady of grace and stability. As I often do, I love to look at people’s names and their meaning and see how well they accomplish the destiny that is hidden in their names. One of the meanings of June is “youth.” As I look at the photo in June’s obituary, I see the youthfulness that always radiated in her eyes. Young is one of the meanings for the name June.

She would quietly without boasting talk to me on Sundays about her prayer times. Through those conversations, I know that her prayer life helped her fulfill another part of her name’s meaning. That meaning is ‘harvest.’ In God’s kingdom economy, our prayers are powerful deposits in God’s spiritual bank that yields great returns. In fact, in Revelation chapter 5 and chapter 8, our prayers are said to be held in Heaven at God’s throne in “golden bowls full of incense, which are the prayers of the saints.” June deposited well. The ‘harvest’ of God’s will be when the angels take those “bowls of incense prayers that are filled with fire from God’s altar and throw it to the earth.” We are yet to see the fullness of the influence and results of her life of intercessory prayer.

One other thing that stands out to me was June’s love for God’s written Word, the Bible, and for His revelatory word through prophecy and messages in tongues. I know that there was a period when every time that God would speak through a message in tongues or prophecy in a worship service at the Tabernacle, June carefully scribed that word. Her meticulous writing down of those messages from God was great evidence of her uncanny

understanding of the importance of God speaking in our lives. I am sure that it would be quite an adventure to be able to go through those spiral notebooks and see the chronicles of God's heart for the people and the destiny of the Tabernacle. June was a keeper and caretaker of God's Word.

In the natural realm, June was very much a true mother. She was a keeper and caretaker of her family. She so loved Donnie and Tommy. June led her sons well. As a single Mom, June provided for 'her boys' in the natural and she provided for them in the spiritual. So today we say to June D Hankins, well done. All of us who were touched by your life are better off for it. You served God and your family well. Now enjoy the blessing of being eternally with our Heavenly Father who loves you so much.

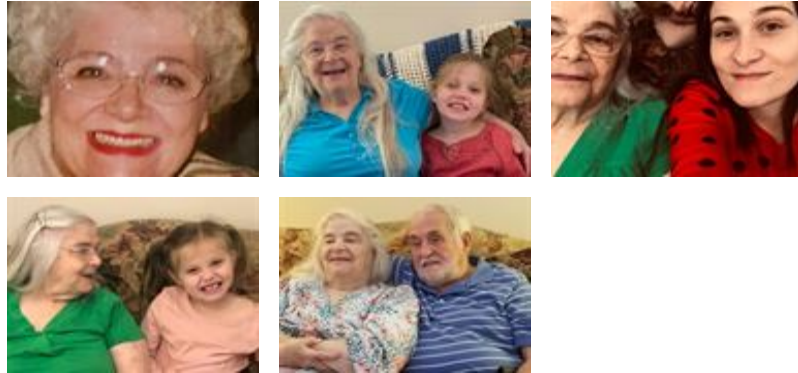
