I can only imagine how lucky a child would've been as your biological child, because being an "adopted" child of your heart was an amazing honor, & something that I may have taken for granted at times. I can't express how deeply my heart is bleeding with sorrow for your passing. I don't know if I should feel angry with grief or breathe sighs of relief that your heartaches are now a thing of your past. nothing. I thought it was hard to leave you when we would visit in Montezuma, I left in tears because you didn't belong there. I wasn't sure how to feel as I walked away from your bedside in the ICU room last Sunday night. I was crying so hard I was shaking then, because you didn't belong there either. Now, I'm trying to prepare myself for what tomorrow will feel like as I must walk away from you for the very last time as your body has been laid to rest next to your sweet Daddy, because in my heart I don't feel like you belong there yet either. I want to be happy for you because of all the memories that I have of you sharing memories of your Daddy with me, & how happy I know you'd be knowing that your wish to be laid next to him for eternity was going to happen. I know you've missed him for so very, very long & this is the part of your passing that I should be able to seek joy from. If there's any joy to be had over it. However, I still don't want to let you go. I guess, I feel like I need to be selfish for once, but I don't have a choice. You're already gone without a fight. I gave the best fight I could & it went unheard. You knew I would though. I must believe that you loved that stubborn part me as much as you loved the rest of me. I saw that same fight in you when I played Kid Rock in your ear. The last time we spoke, you begged me to not fight for you because it'd make things easier in the long run.
