Kathryn Williams passed away on Wednesday, October 28, 2015 of a massive heart attack at the age of 93. She graduated from Atlanta Girls High School in 1939. She then went on to graduate from the University of Georgia, Atlanta Division in 1953 with a business management degree. She had a long healthcare career dedicating her life to caring for others. She worked for Dr. Dan Martin from 1950 until the time of his death in 1991. She was known fondly to thousands of patients in Gwinnett County as Miss Williams, Dr. Martin's nurse. She was a member of Park Avenue Baptist Church for 60 years and also a long time Sunday School teacher. She quite often picked up many homebound members so they could attend church. Those who knew her were aware of her love of sports. She played amateur basketball for the Sports Arena Blues in Atlanta, winning a National Title in 1947. She also loved tennis and was active in ALTA for 15 years playing with her sister Bettie Jo Polson and her niece Nina Striplin. She was a constant cheerleader at every Brookwood baseball, basketball, football and soccer game that two of her grand nephews, Beau and Wade Brogdon, played in. She was counted on to provide after school rides and meals to many of their Brookwood Broncos teammates for many years. She also loved attending many soccer games of her grand-nephew Zach Brownfield. While she never married or had children of her own, she was like an adopted mother for her many nieces and nephews and their children and she could always be counted on to provide needed financial support for their endeavors and adventures. She was especially

proud of her grand-nephew Aaron Scobie who will be graduating from Auburn University in December. She is preceded in death by her mother Carrie Vesta Jones Williams and father Daniel Milton Williams, Sr. of Clayhatchee, Alabama. She had six siblings: Dan Williams, Jr.*, Evelyn Striplin, twins Ted* and Fred Williams, Bettie Jo Polson and Emma Ree Scobie*. She had 17 nieces and nephews: Danny, Mark, Frank, Jerry, Mike (Cash) Nina, Patricia, Pam, Diane, Freddie*, Ted, Larry, Kathy, Georgia, Jack, Carrie and Joe*.
