During that visit, she gave me a Siamese cat that I named Dixie. The name seemed to fit. Her mother also let me drive their pickup truck which was the first time that I ever drove a vehicle.

A few years later, my friend and I drove to Athens, GA to see Kay. I was a shy young man and did not let her know how I felt about her although she might have known.

Life happened as it normally does and we both had gotten married. Then in 2005, I was single again. But Kay was married and I knew that I could not contact her.

Last week, I was watching the Alabama, Georgia national championship game on television and thought about how Kay must be loving the game. Georgia was ahead at the time. The next day, I googled her name hoping to find some blurb about her success in life. When someone says that they felt like the air was sucked out of the room, that is how I felt. There it was...her obituary listing.

I had no idea that she was sick and had moved back to their farm. I could never pretend to know how this tragedy affected her. I do know that I missed opportunities to get to know her better. I look back and remember this beautiful woman both inside and out and realize that she will be forever in my thoughts.
