Katherine (Kay) Jeannette Lancaster, age 83, of Lawrenceville, Georgia (formerly of Conyers, Georgia) passed away on April 6, 2009 at Embracing Hospice in Snellville, Georgia. Kay was known as "NANA" to all who knew and loved her. Nana was born in Walton County on January 26, 1926 to Ranie & Susie Lee Atha. She had two brothers, Emory Atha and Wilbur Atha. After her family moved to East Atlanta, she met and married Harry Taylor Lancaster on October 26, 1946. During her early married years, she worked as a Credit Passer for Sears Roebuck & Co., a salesperson for the Jack Fred Co.
