



## L.T. (Lonzo Thomas) Everett

August 23, 1932 - December 21, 2021

L.T. (Lonzo Thomas) Everett (89), our terrific Father, Big Daddy, brother, uncle and friend changed his address on Tuesday December 21, 2021 when he was welcomed into his Savior's presence at 12:06 PM. After seeing Jesus, he was reunited with his wife Geraldine who he has missed so much since her Homegoing in 2016. He also rejoined his parents, Herbert & Mamie (McMillian) Everett, Stepmother Eva Everett, brothers Dewey,

Louie & Huie and his precious sister Louise Hall. There were many other loved ones, friends and many, many spiritual children waiting to welcome him as well. L. T. was born & raised in the Harbins/Dacula area of Georgia. He met Geraldine at Dacula high school and they married shortly after graduation in 1951. He served in the Army during the Korean War & was stationed in Berlin, Germany. L.T. gave his heart to the Lord in January 1960. A few years later, a group of friends began Hawthorne Baptist Church & the meetings were held in L.T. & Geraldine's basement in Tucker, GA. At one of the church's revival meetings in the 1960s, L.T. & Geraldine answered God's call to full-time Christian service. They sold their home & moved to Chattanooga, TN to attend Tennessee Temple Bible College graduating in June 1969 & leaving for Bolivia in July with their 2 children, Greg & Melanie to share the Gospel of Christ. After language school in

Cochabama, they moved to the rural village of San Juan del Potrero where

they had the joy of ministering for about 8 years. They traveled to nearby villages including Santa Rosa where the largest village church was started. In 1979 they moved to the city of Santa Cruz to begin a church with believers who had moved there from the villages. Early in their ministry they faced much discouragement when they weren't seeing many come to know Christ but the Lord blessed their faithfulness and their ministry has grown to 40+ churches, a camp ministry (Camp David), a deaf ministry, childrens' home & a Seminary. The work of the Lord continues on with faithful Pastors & leaders for which we are so thankful!

L.T. leaves behind his son Greg and wife Kathy of Flowery Branch, his daughter Melanie Everett of Dacula and grandchildren, Bryan (Katie) Everett, Whitney (Jordan) Futch,

Kelly (Josh) Perkinson, Emily Everett, many spiritual children in Bolivia including a surrogate daughter, Gerarda Valverde. He is also survived by his sister Ann Kemp, brother Doug (Vicky) Everett, sister-in-law Verlyn Everett and many beloved nieces, nephews and cousins.

L.T. was a faithful member of Collins Hill Baptist Church where he taught Sunday School & ministered in other areas until his brain injury & failing health.

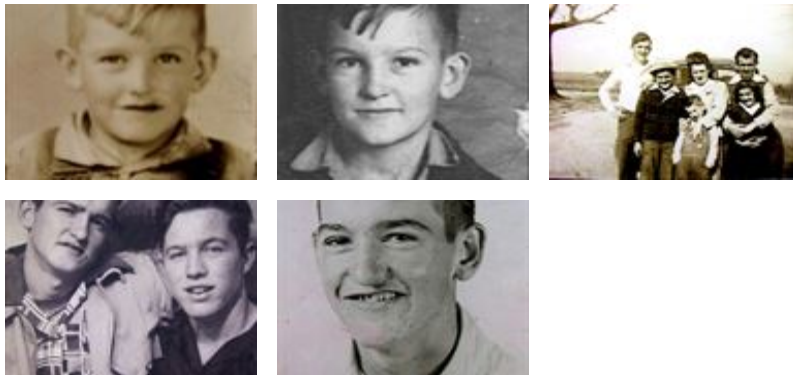
