ZAENGLEIN - Lance Zaenglein, age 50 of Flowery Branch, GA, passed away on Thursday, March 12, 2026. 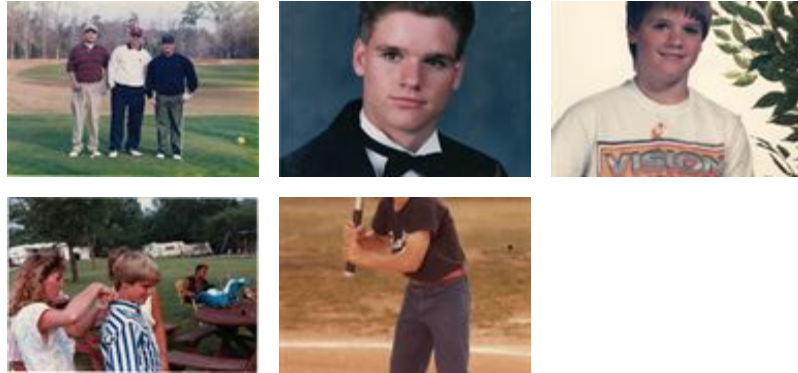
