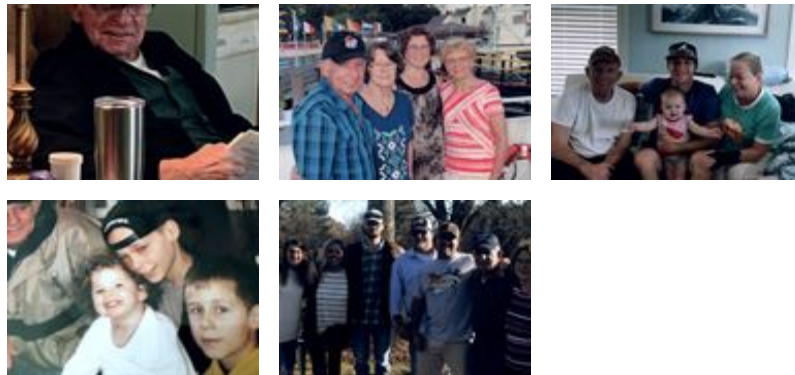
“ Dear Shawn and Dana,
