



Loma Jacobs Weiss

December 14, 1910 - February 18, 2012

WEISS - Loma Jacobs Weiss, age 101 of Loganville, passed away on Saturday, February 18, 2012. Funeral Services will be held at 11 AM on Tuesday, February 21, 2012 at Loganville First United Methodist Church with Dr. David Gravitt and Minister Clark McPherson officiating. The body will lie in state at 10:30AM. Entombment will follow at Westview Cemetery, Atlanta. Mrs. Weiss was born to the late Ed and Alyce Jacobs on December 14, 1910. She left Atlanta during the Depression to move to Chicago for work. She worked as a secretary for Home Insurance, Red Head Outfitters, and Oscar Mayer. She relocated to Atlanta during the 1940's, and there she met her first husband, William T. Coakley. She volunteered with the Red Cross at St. Josephs Hospital. After the death of her husband in 1944, she moved to New York where she continued her secretarial work for the British Government during WWII. She also worked for Callaway Mills and Earle & Jones, where she was a secretary for both. She remarried in 1964 to Louis Goodman Weiss and retired from work. They moved back to Atlanta to be closer to family in 1977. Mr. Weiss passed away in 1987. Mrs. Weiss relocated to Loganville in 2000 and was a member of Loganville First United Methodist Church. Mrs. Weiss loved to travel the world. She had the great privilege of knowing people, such as Amelia Earhardt, Beatrice Potter, whom she was good friends with, and Jack Dempsey. Mrs. Weiss is survived by her Cousins: Joe and Diane Palmer; Betty Jo and Ron Smith, all of Loganville; Christi Palmer, Woodstock; Angie and Richie Taylor and Family, Monroe; Laurie, Chuck, and

James Bingham, Clarkesville; Bobby McCullers, Loganville; Several other cousins also survive.
