Brownlee, Milton D. "Buck" departed this life August 25, 2015 at the age of 91. He was owner and manager of Brownlee Fertilizer Feed and Seed for many years before retiring in 1988. He was a quiet, kind, hardworking man that served and cared deeply for his family. He inspired his children to do their best with integrity and commitment in whatever they did. Buck was a member and past Worshipful Master of Grayson Masonic Lodge # 549. 2001 60 plus years he loved his row and was

not satisfied unless the row was straight. Buck was a member and Deacon Emeritus of First Baptist Church of Grayson where he served in many different capacities over the years. Buck did volunteer work in prison ministry since October of 1988 each Tuesday evening in the Library of the prison. Mr. Brownlee loved Grayson (town and community). He served as Mayor or Council Member for twenty five plus years—walking the second mile many times to help Grayson be the town she is. No task was too menial. He hauled garbage when necessary and worked faithfully to keep her alcohol free during his tenure. He lived his principles and beliefs through quiet, selfless actions. Buck lived a life of service for his Lord, his family, community, and country. If he gave you his word, you could take it to the bank. He championed honesty and reliability. He wanted people to know that in the worst circumstances there is hope. He served a cause greater than self for his lord, his family, his community, and his country. 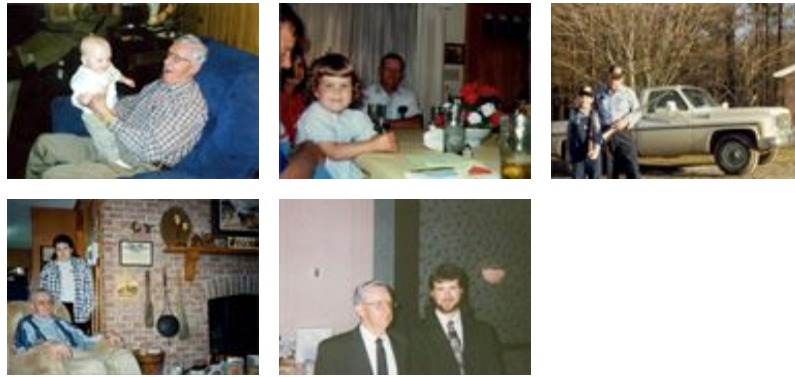
