* **Mable Maud was born February 6, 1938 in Mile Gully, Manchester, on the beautiful island of Jamaica to Arthur and Beatrice Shields, Mable was the youngest of four siblings, Victor, Louise and Eugennie. ***

* **As a child Mable enjoyed nature and being out-doors, in fact, two of her favorite activities were climbing trees and gardening. Though, what she cherished most of all was music. As a very young girl she loved to sing in church with her sister Eugennie. They were often asked to sing at various church functions, whether it was a revival service or gospel concert.***

* **As a young adult Mable worked many years as a primary school teacher in Jamaica. Although she loved working with children, her goal was to become a nurse to help those who could not help themselves.***

*In September of 1967, Mable married Ivan Nembhard and the following month

migrated to the United States, where she became a geriatric nurse. She was later joined by her husband in 1969, at which time they had their first child Sophie. Mable continued her work as a nurse well into the mid-seventies, but after the birth of her second child, she decided to spend more time at home raising her children and continue her career later.***

*In 1975, while searching for a church to call her own, Mable found Christian Fellowship Seventh-day Adventist Church. Once she became a member, she wasted no time joining the choir and working in cradle roll. It was not too long before people noticed her beautiful soprano voice and soon asked her to sing for Sabbath school and during divine-hour service.** *

*Mable was not a very talkative person, but she always made a statement in her cooking. She loved preparing all sorts of edible delights for her family, but once news got out at church that she loved to cook, the requests started pouring in. ***

* **No matter the request, Mable never denied an opportunity to give of herself for the church she loved and the God she served.*

*Mable Maud Nembhard, age 72 of Lawrenceville, Georgia, passed away peacefully at her home on Wednesday, August 4, 2010. Mable was the last of her siblings to pass away. ***
