Margaret T. Nash, 94, passed away on December 4, 2014. Mrs. Nash was the second daughter and third child of seven children of Luther Monroe Turpin and Amanda Magnolia Smith Turpin and grew up in Lakemont, GA and Smyrna, GA. Mrs. Nash survived the death of her first husband, O'Neill Williams, who died in 1943 in service to his country in WWII six weeks after the birth of their son. In 1946, she married another war combat Army veteran, Henry Otis ('HO'). Nash, Jr., who, as a B-29 radio operator, flew 25 missions over Japan, and to whom she was married for 67 years until his death in April of 2014. In high school she was graded A+ in all subjects, captain of both the track and basketball teams and was voted Most Athletic by the Fitzhugh Lee High School graduating class of 1938. Mrs. Nash worked with AT&T until she remarried. After the birth of her second son, she dedicated her life to her husband and sons as wife, mother and home maker for eight years eventually re-entering the work force as a doctor's assistant in Ophthalmology for the 38-year balance of her career. She is survived by two sons, O'Neill Williams (Gail) of Snellville, and Hank Nash (Karen) of Porter, Indiana, five grandchildren, Amy (Tim) Johnson of Jersey, GA, Allison (Joe) Moravec, of Bethlehem, GA, Emily Harris of Woodstock, GA, Lindsay Nash of Bloomington, Indiana, Evan Nash of Porter, Indiana and seven great grandchildren, Travis Johnson and Lorrie Johnson of Jersey, GA, Cody
