younger cousins, always making sure everyone around her felt safe and supported. She loved walking outdoors, organizing and cleaning her home, and creating a beautiful space for her family. Born in Colombia, Camila loved returning to her home country to visit family and celebrate her culture. She loved to dance, to be surrounded by loved ones, and to laugh. Her joy was infectious and her spirit unforgettable. Camila is survived by her son, Noah Halla; her parents, Maria Hozman Baron and Jorge E. “ I am a dietitian and eating disorder clinician who knew Camilla for many years before her tragic illness completely took over. What I remember most about Camilla was her intelligence, her perseverance, and her intense drive and desire to heal. I want people to understand that she truly, truly tried to stop those unwanted thoughts and compulsions that took over. She fully understood how illogical they were. She fully understood how destructive they were. She fully understood that she would regret every unwanted behavior. Yet an illness this big was just too convincing. And this was the greatest tragedy of all. I want people to understand that it was never about Camilla not trying hard enough or being selfish or uncaring towards those around her. Camilla's biggest wish of all was to be the best daughter, mother, sister, friend, and nurse. With an illness like this, it's not that you won't recover but that you can't recover.

When Camilla tackled nursing school in the midst of an illness of that magnitude, I was shocked and so impressed. The fact that she was able to do the work and pass the exams was a testament to her intelligence and drive. She was desperate to provide a good life for Noah and to not rely on her parents. She was incredibly grateful for her parents and the help and support that they provided for Noah and for her.

Camilla made a profound impact on my life. She was just really special. I will miss her so much. ❤️
