Martha Fay Funderburg Paden of Conyers passed away Thursday, July 23, at the age of 103. She was born July 14, 1917 in Gwinnett County, Georgia, the eighth and youngest child of Daniel Jackson Funderburg and Martha Alice Humphries Funderburg. She was a graduate of Lawrenceville High School.

Martha, or Martha Fay to family members and Grandmama to the youngsters, was an active and dedicated Christian lady. She served at church camps, prepared meals, fed preachers, taught children, and worked diligently at Peachcrest Christian Church, Bethel Christian Church, and for the last 30 years at Corinth Christian Church.
