She graduated from Sullins College in Virginia, received her Bachelor of Science from Georgia State College, and her Masters, Summa Cum Laude, from the University of Georgia, Athens.

MaryLynne married Ronald Trent Solomon of Kingsport, Tn on November 28, 1959, in Catonsville, Maryland. They lived in Kingsport, Tn, soon after moved to Georgia, and eventually settled in Monroe. She served on the Boards of Rukert Terminals and Beacon Stevedoring in Baltimore, Maryland. MaryLynne also served on the Board of F.I.S.H., and was a volunteer there as well. She

was a counselor for many years at Family Services in Gainesville, Ga. She served as Senior Warden of the Vestry at St. Albans Episcopal Church, Monroe, Ga., and also was instrumental in creating, and serving, as a St. Albans Stephens Minister.

She was a member of Holy Cross Anglican Cathedral in Loganville, Ga.
