Bell- Michael Sutherland Bell age 64 of Stone Mountain passed away Friday, December 27, 2013. A Graveside service will be held Tuesday, December 31, 2013 at 12:00 PM at Georgia National Cemetery, 1080 Veterans Cemetery Road, Canton, GA 30114. Bio:

Mr. Bell was a U.S. Army Veteran, Spec. 4, who served in Vietnam from July 1968 to July 1969. He specifically served in Company C of the 86th "Viking"

Engineer Battalion (Combat) of the 20th Engineer Brigade as well as a stint there in an infantry unit. He was awarded The Army Commendation Medal for meritorious service while serving in Vietnam. He later served with Company A of the 82nd Engineer Battalion in Bamberg, Germany. He was the owner of "Records Galore" on E. Ponce De Leon Ave. in Clarkston, GA since January, 1981 – the longest running business (33 years) in Clarkston. He also extended his business operations to international markets. Mr. Bell was a lifelong collector of vintage vinyl record albums and 45s, preferring popular solo artists of the 1950s and 1960s, including John Gary and Julie London, as well as icons such as Bing Crosby and Elvis Presley. He also passionately collected vintage trading cards of the sports stars from his youth and attended national collectors conventions. He loved sports history, and his favorite hero was fellow Georgian and Baseball Hall of Famer, Ty Cobb. Mr. Bell was partial to older movies and was a fan of Errol Flynn, Marilyn Monroe, Laurel & Hardy, and of classic TV westerns like "Have Gun, Will Travel". He is survived by his Mother: Alice Bell of Lawrenceville; Brother & Sister-in-law: Chris & Linda Bell of Buford; Sisters: Lydia Vogtner of Sausalito, CA, Becky Greenway of Norcross; 3 Nieces: Julie Griffin, Mindy Reynolds, and Kasey Bell; 1 Nephew: Lee Greenway; & 1 Great Niece: Emily Reynolds. Mr. Bell's greatest joy was his love of babies and specifically of these nieces, nephew and younger siblings.
