



## Michael L. Jordan

January 11, 1959 - March 4, 2015

At 10:13 AM on March 4, 2015 the trumpets resounded the entrance of Michael Lynn Jordan of Dacula, Georgia to the gates of Heaven. He had fought valiantly to survive a lung transplant necessitated by pulmonary fibrosis that showed no mercy. Michael was born January 11, 1959 to Vernon and Shirley Devore Jordan. As a young child, Mike was fairly typical but excelled at the sport of football. So much so that, in his senior year at Berkmar High School in Lilburn, he was chosen as co-All-county back the same year that future Heisman candidate George Rogers was chosen for the same position. After a short stint at Liberty Baptist College, Mike chose to enter the car business where he excelled. After various entry level positions, he was hired as the New Car Manager at Stone Mountain Ford. After a short time he was promoted to General Manager and then to a Vice President with the parent company. From there he went on to become the dealer principal at Heritage Lincoln Mercury for twelve years. After that business was successfully sold to consolidators, Mike then, free-lanced as a “fixer” for other troubled dealerships and did an amazing job. Then, seeking a change, Mike chose to become a boat dealer and, again, excelled. When his dear friend, Bill Huseby, the dealer principal of Mall of Georgia Ford, was stricken with lymphoma, Mike chose to step in for Bill until Bill recovered. His thought was that he would be there to hand the keys back to Bill. Unfortunately, Bill never recovered and Mike found himself in a position he’d never hoped to inhabit. Nonetheless, Mike excelled and became the largest Ford dealership in the region with Van Tuyl

Automotive Group. Shortly after, Mike contracted a respiratory virus that took him over a four year struggle that no one should experience. His lungs slowly deteriorated to the point where a lung transplant was the only alternative. Fortunately, he was able to make a contact with the Mayo Clinic and they were able to get him approved for a lung transplant. Though it was accomplished initially, over time, Mike's body was just too weak to assimilate the transplant. He is pre-deceased by his father, Vernon Jordan and survived by his amazing and ever-loving wife Laura Krueger Jordan. His children Christopher and Kendra Jordan. Mother Shirley DeVore Jordan ; Brother Darryl Jordan and many other family and close friends.

A memorial service in his honor will be held at Saturday March 14, 2015 2Pm at Crosspointe Church, 1800 Satellite Blvd, Duluth Georgia with Pastor Chad Logan Officiating.
