King -Michael Lennon King age 69, known to his friends as Jack, died on Saturday, May 2, 2009. Jack was born in Boston, MA to Dr. William D. and Marge King, and was raised in Birmingham AL. Jack's 25+ year career with 3M corporation took he and wife Virginia and their 3 children from Birmingham, to Charlotte, NC, to Fairfield, CT, to Atlanta, GA, and to Menomonee, WI - with Jack making life long friends at every stop. Upon his retirement, Jack relocated to Palm Coast, FL, where he was an avid golfer. Jack never met a stranger, a trait that served him well in his career as a salesman. Jack's career put him at the forefront of the technological changes in modern recorded media, as he was continually tapped to use his sales skills to launch new technologies. During his career, Jack participated in the transition from 8-Track to Cassette audio and then to compact disc. Later in his career, Jack was tapped to help launch a new AV media that began as a product called Laser Video Disk that ultimately became the modern DVD. Jack is survived by his 3 sons: David, Todd, and Tim; 3 daughters- in law: Holly, Tabitha and Alexandra as well as 4 grandchildren: Caswell, CJ, Grace and Cameron; siblings: Pat, Tim, Dennis, and Kathy.
